West Chester University, and University of Delaware just to name a few.

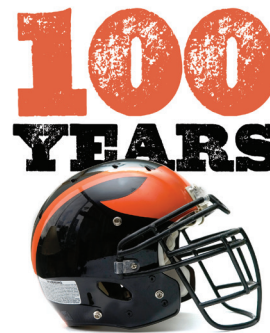

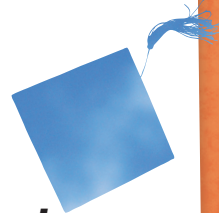

## All Nighthawk Athletes & Parents

All student-athletes must have a current physical on file to be eligible for athletics. Physicals may be completed at a family doctor or medical express clinic and must be dated June 1, 2023, or after.
